British people send greeting cards and give Easter eggs to their family and friends.

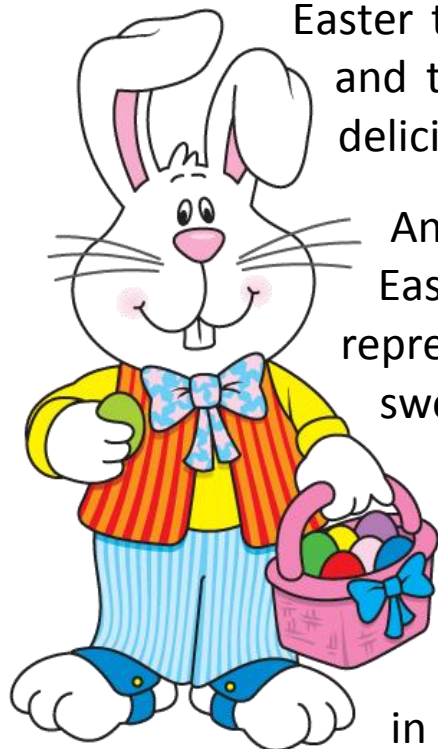
Eggs, chicks and hot cross buns are symbols of Easter.

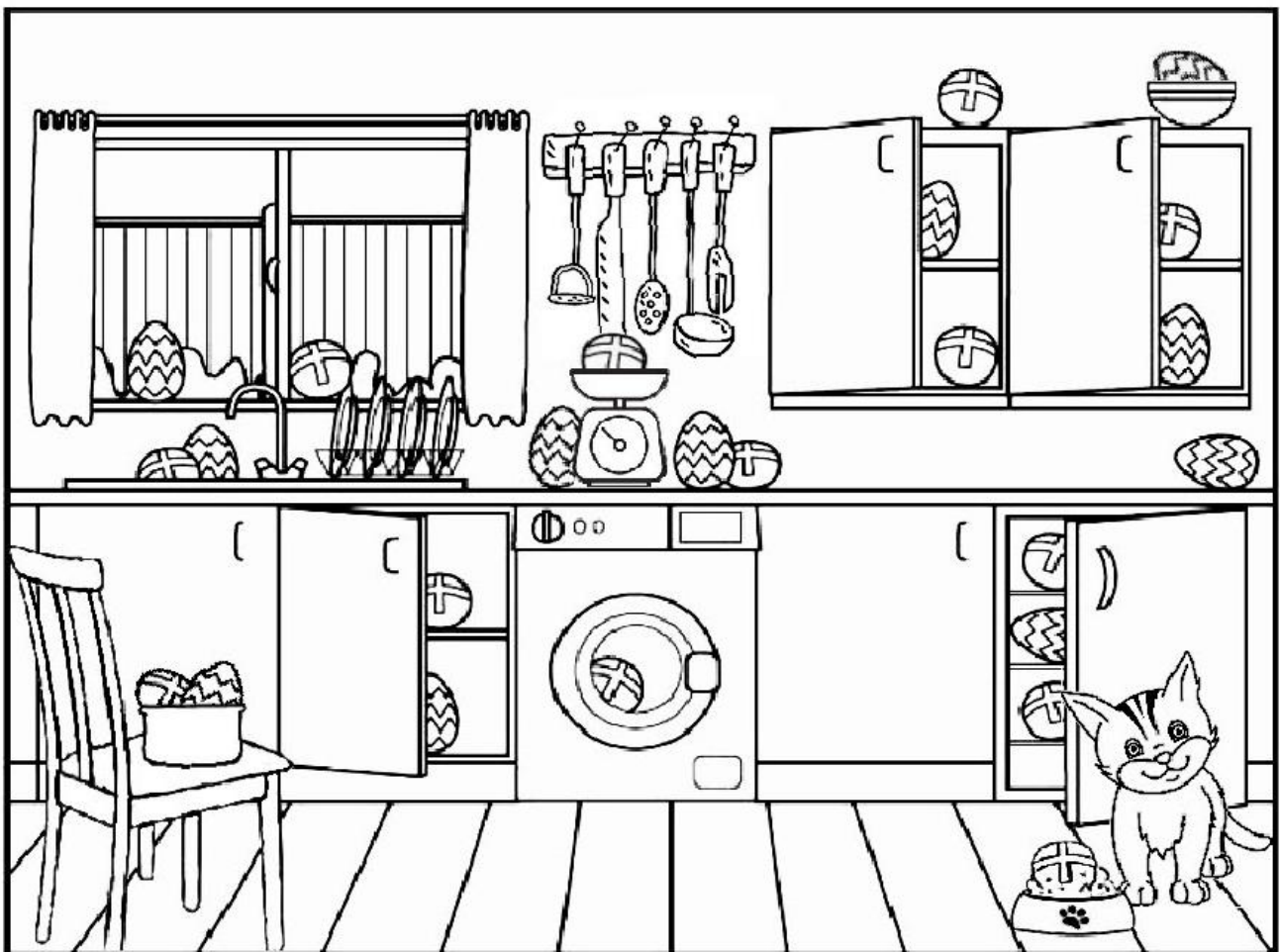
