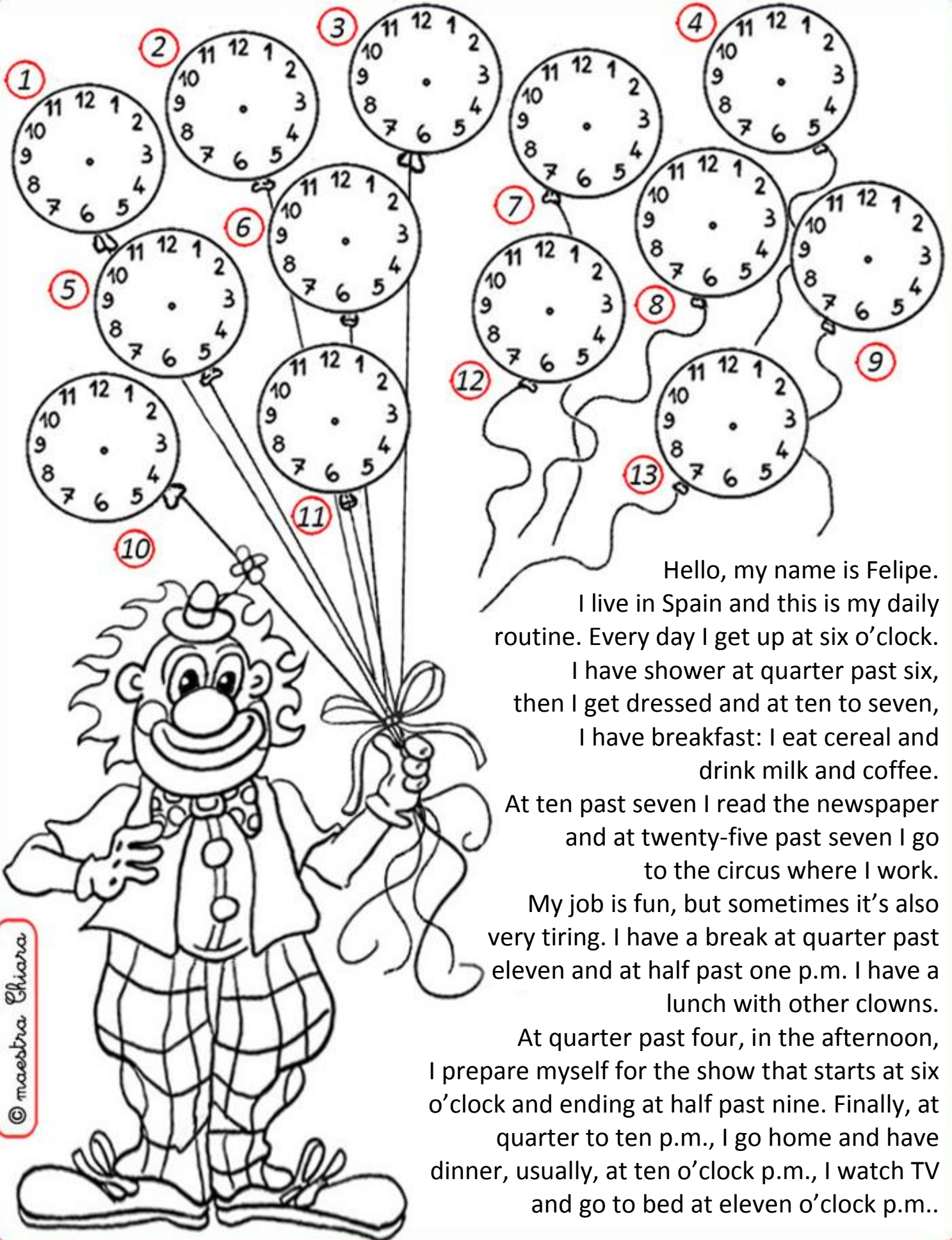


What's the time...? It's Clown time!
