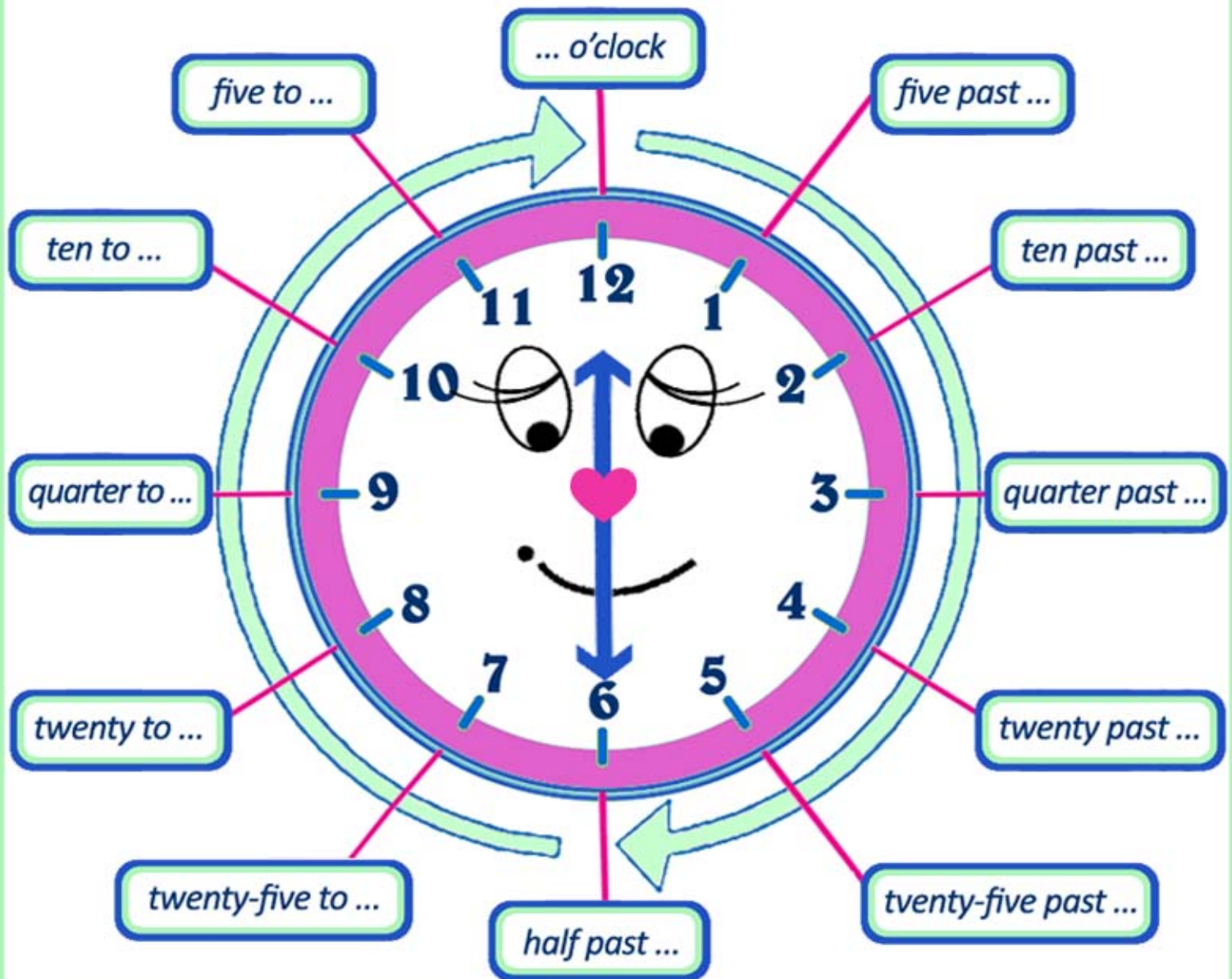


TELLING THE TIME



REMEMBER

Clocks have two arrows, which we call "hands".
The long hand shows the minutes. It is on the 6.
It is called the minute hand.

The short hand shows the hours. It is on the 12.
It is called the hour hand.

The time is: half past twelve or 12:30.

It's twelve o'clock a.m.



It's midday

a. m. – ante meridiem
(before midday)

It's twelve o'clock p.m.



It's midnight

p. m. – post meridiem
(after midday)

We use **IN** and **AT** for
talking about time.

IN the morning

IN the afternoon

IN the evening

IN 5 minutes

AT noon

AT midnight

AT 2 o'clock

AT 11:30
